- 3. The following minor changes are made in the syllabus and are approved
  - a. In the course content of M.Pharm Pharmaceutics, Course No. MPH2041 in Cosmetics and Cosmeceuticals is replaced with the course title Formulation Development of Pharmaceutical and Cosmetic Products. The syllabi of this course is as given in the Appendix-I
  - b. For all 10 specializations, the Practical-I that is prescribed in First Semester is divided into two practicals, Practical-I and Practical II, each for 75 marks carrying 3 Credit points.
