Annual Report 2021-22

Aditya college of pharmacy has commenced working from the academic year 2006. The first batch of students has passed out in the year 2010. College name has been changed from Sri sai Aditya Institute of sciences and technology to Aditya college of pharmacy in 2016. ACOP is approved by UGC under sec 2f, PCI & AICTE and it is affiliated to JNTUK. ACOP also initiated for ISO certification and participating in NIRF since academic year 2016. ACOP provides good infrastructure for holistic development of students and faculty members. The college has started the post graduate courses like Pharmaceutical technology and Pharmacology (M. Pharm) from 2010. The college has started the Pharm.D Course from the year 2014. Total number of students admitted in the college for this year is 130. Students strength of the college is 584. There are total 43 mentors for 584 mentees.

The College has over the years acquired advanced scientific equipment and installed in various laboratories. Realizing the importance of web based learning the management has provided a high speed internet laboratory for the students. ACOP also offers Add on courses for the students which help the students to think out of the box. Total 5 courses were offered this year for students and 474 students were enrolled in it in this academic year. The students are given coaching in the III and IV year for the GPAT examination. Total 11 students qualified in various competitive exams like GPAT and PGE CET.

There is enormous collection of books and journals which are subscribed regularly. The institution has purchased micromedex database, DELNET, subscription for e-resource KNIMBUS. The annual expenditure for the purchase of books and journal and data base is 509967/-

Total percentage of Full time teachers against sanctioned post is 100%. The college has 5 Qualified Ph D holders.

Number of research papers published on UGC/SCI/SCOPUS indexed Journals during the last five years are 55.

5 research papers were published in this academic year.

ACOP also carries extension activities for sensitizing students to social issues. This year 10 extension activities were carried out in neighbourhood community. From last 5 years 56 programmes were conducted and 521 students were participated in this academic year.

Vanamahostava Program i.e., Planting of trees was celebrated at Surampalem. Students have Planted the saplings near the premises of Grama Sachivalayam and also distributed saplings to the authorities. International Yoga Day celebrations are conducted under the expert guidance of M. Ramakrishna yoga trainer from Pulimeru. Pharma-D students were actively Participated in the Hospital Gandhi organized at Krishna campaign MEDICAL CAMP chakrabundham, Rjy. The NSS volunteers undertook household survey under Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan at kotapadu in order to collect general information related to household. Villages are aware about the schemes getting from Govt of India. Aditya college of pharmacy NSS Unit conducted a blood donation camp with help of "ABHAYA BLOOD BANK" Kakinada. Students of B. Pharmacy and Pharm.D handmade cloth bags by their own and were actively participated in Distribution of hand made cloth bags and awareness on reducing plastic pollution organized at Mahalakshmi temple, Surampalem.

The students of B.Pharm, M.Pharm and Pharm.D in ACOP are made to undertake projects/ internship.Total 103 students from B.Pharmacy, 20 students from Pharm.D,9 students from M.Pharmacy undertaken project works. 24 students from pharm.D undertaken internships. Total MOUs since last 5 years is 16. Total number of students benefited with scholarships this year is 292. Number of students appeared for examination is 139,number of students passed 123 and pass percentage of students in this academic year was found to be 88.48% Students of B.Pharm and Pharm.D from ACOP are placed in Techsol life sciences,MSN laboratories pvt ltd, Acuity solutions, Episource, Teena biolabs pvt ltd.

Total number of sports and cultural events conducted in this academic year are 3 and 7 respectively. Number of seminars conducted in this academic year is one.

The institution has a transparent mechanism for timely redressal of student grievances including sexual harassment and anti ragging committee. No grievances for students and faculty were observed in this academic year. Total 25 committees were present in the institution. Total number of students benefited by career guidance and career counseling in this academic year is 235.

Total 6 FDP'S were conducted this year.

Aditya college of pharmacy established the IQAC officially on 4th July,2018.Right from the inception,IQAC has been an integral part in developing a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the overall performance of the college. It is committed towards quality enhancement initiatives in higher education.Quality initiatives taken by IQAC in this year includes conduction of meetings,audits,NIRF participation,ISO certification,created awareness about plagiarism and malpractices in writing publications,applied for NAAC.

ACOP conducts quality audits such as green audit, energy audit and environment audit. An eco club has been formed by the institute where active participation of faculty and students are involved for maintaining and conserving the better environment.

- To enhance skills for the students regarding the significance of the environment and the consequences faced upon environmental devastation.
- To encourage students for active participation in the environmental conserving activities.
- To inculcate the moral sense of environmental studies through many innovative approaches.
