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Annual Report 2022-23

Aditya college of pharmacy has commenced working from the academic year 2006. The first batch of students has passed out in the year 2010. College name has been changed from Sri sai Aditya Institute of sciences and technology to Aditya college of pharmacy in 2016. ACOP is approved by UGC under sec 2f, PCI & AICTE and it is affiliated to JNTUK. ACOP is certified with ISO and participating in NIRF since academic year 2016. ACOP provides good infrastructure for holistic development of students and faculty members. The college has started the post graduate courses like Pharmaceutical technology and Pharmacology (M. Pharm) from 2010. The college has started the Pharm.D Course from the year 2014. The students of B.Pharm, M.Pharm and Pharm.D in ACOP are made to undertake projects/ internship/ field works. Total 148 students undergone project this year. out of that 113 are B.Pharmacy, 15 M.Pharmacy and 20 Pharm.D students.

The College has over the years acquired advanced equipment and installed in various laboratories. The institution has invited quotations from reputed manufacturers for further procurement of advanced equipment this year. Realizing the importance of web based learning the management has provided a high speed internet laboratory for the students. ACOP also offers Add on courses for the Students which help the students to think out of the box. Total 6 courses were offered this year for students and 493 students were enrolled in it in this academic year. Total number of students admitted in the college for this year is 162. Students strength of the college is 612. There are total 43 mentors for 612 mentees.

Average percentage of full time teachers against sanctioned post is 100%.The college has 7 qualified Ph.D holders. ACOP also carries extension activities for sensitizing students to social issues. This year 16 extension activities were carried out in neighbourhood community. Total 588 students were participated in this academic year. Certificate of appreciation for blood donation by students of Aditya college of pharmacy by medical officer of government hospital, Rampachodavarm. There is huge collection of books and journals which are subscribed regularly. The institution has subscription for e-resources. This year DELNET and KNIMBUS were subscribed and registered for E-Shodh. The annual expenditure for the purchase of books and journal and data base is 551759/-. Total number of students benefited with scholarships this year is 247.

The students are given coaching in the III and IV year for the GPAT examination. Total 301 students were given coaching for competitive exams this year. Total 16 students qualified in GPAT and 182 students in PGE CET including one student in IELET from 2016-17 to 2021-22.

Number of faculty having the guideship for this year is one. Number of faculty registered for Ph.D are 2. Number of seminars conducted on research methodology, IPR and entrepreneurship are 2.Total 16 research papers published this year. Total 2 collaborative activities were conducted. The institution has conducted collaborative activity with NOVEL PATENT SERVICES, Vishakpatnam. Final year B.Pharm students were taken for industrial visit to Seldom pvt Ltd, Yanam. Till now the institution has 16 MOU's.

The institution has a transparent mechanism for timely redressal of student grievances including sexual harassment and anti ragging committee. No grievances for students and faculty were observed in this academic year. Total 25 committees were present in the institution.

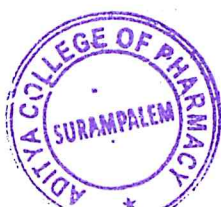

package. Total number of students selected for placements in this academic year is 48. Total number of students went for higher education from outgoing students this year is 17. Total 7 students qualified in state/national/international exams.

Total 3 awards were received by the students of ACOP in university/state level sports competitions. Total 5 sport competitions and 13 cultural programs were conducted by the institution this year.

Aditya college of pharmacy established the IQAC officially on 4th July, 2018. Right from the inception, IQAC has been an integral part in developing a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the overall performance of the college. It is committed towards quality enhancement initiatives in higher education. This year 3 meetings were conducted by IQAC. SSR was submitted successfully to NAAC on 16th, September 2022. NAAC peer team visited to ACOP and the college has accredited with grade A. A programme “concept and carriers of novel drug delivery systems” was conducted for final year B.pharm student students by Dr. Pyla sreerama murthy, Principal of KITS college of pharmacy. Quotations for advanced scientific equipment prepared and sent. A seminar on “strategic planning for higher education and career in pharmacy” was conducted. A seminar on “Research methodology for applying projects” was conducted. The institution participated in NIRF. This year 21 faculty attended online and face to face FDPs. Number of faculty provided with financial support to attend conferences/workshops in this academic year is 23. Total 5 FDP’S were conducted this year, out of which 3 were conducted for teaching faculty and 2 for non teaching faculty.

The institution has conducted 3 programs under ethics committee. Internal practices of code of conduct, one day student orientation program and voters identification under SVEEP program. The institution has also conducted 5 gender sensitive programs to promote gender equality.




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
