Based on recommendations of NAAC peer team, Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted by IQAC in the month of JUNE, 2023 for AY 2022-2023. Each question in the NAAC SSS format is aimed at collecting factual opinion of students on teachers approach, preparedness, attitude of teachers, transparency and fairness in internal evaluations, curricular and extra-curricular activities, overall impression and suggestions about the college. This simple but important exercise definitely helps to improve the relevance of teaching and learning. This survey corresponds to an institute level feedback on infrastructure and learning experience. The student responses were collected through google forms containing relevant questions. Link is provided in class groups of students. Before proceeding for the survey, the name(optional), year, academic programme being pursued by the student were confirmed. Key findings from the survey

1. A high percentage of students (69.9%) are completely satisfied with the way their teachers prepare for class.
2. Regarding the pharmacy course offered in the institution 26.3% of students said it was excellent, while 35.3% of students said it was very good.
- 3.satisfaction regarding teachers approach to teach the subject is maximum 48.1%
- 4.Students have appreciated the teachers attitude towards fairness in evaluation.41.45% believed that the evaluation is usually fair and for 39.1% it is always fair.
5. 54.1% opinioned that teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilitates them in cognitive,social and emotional growth.

6. Institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process (44.4%)
7. 31.6% strongly agree and 42.9% agree that teachers will encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities
8. Highest percentage 51.9% students expressed that 70-90% teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector.
9. Students were highly satisfied regarding books in the library were sufficient for learning.
10. Students were satisfied for practical sessions in the institution. But they are highly dissatisfied for hospital/industrial visits by the college.

Based on the analysis and report, taking consideration of students suggestions to improve quality of the institute IQAC suggestions are as follows:

- 1) Hands On Sessions and interdisciplinary learning programs, organisation of various seminars, workshops and field visits will help students in learning other subjects/ practicals which were beyond their prescribed curriculum.
- 2) The SSS has also pointed out few grey areas where the college/ teachers/ departments do have scope for enhancement in quality of education. They are as follows:
 - A). Formulate mechanism which will identify strength and weakness of students and provide them right level of challenges and help them to overcome their weakness.
 - B). Enhance use of ICT in teaching and equip laboratories with multiple copies of small instruments.
- 3). Teachers should encourage research culture among students by teaching in research prospective
- 4) Active mentorship especially for career guidance.
- 5) Design interdisciplinary courses.
- 6) Implementation of yoga sessions, meditation classes relieves the stress and will improve cognitive skills.

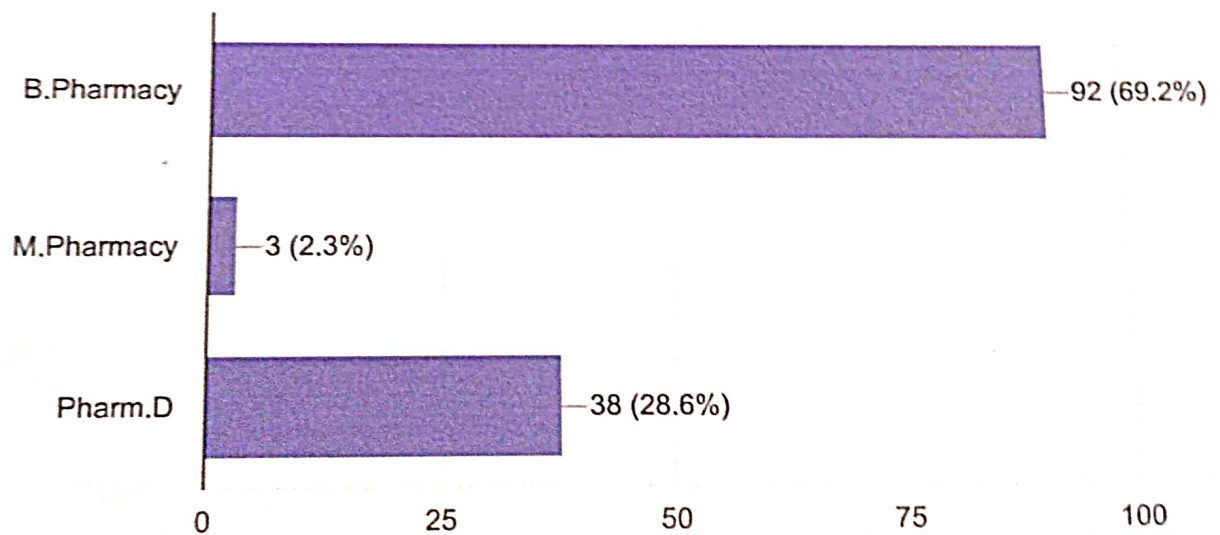

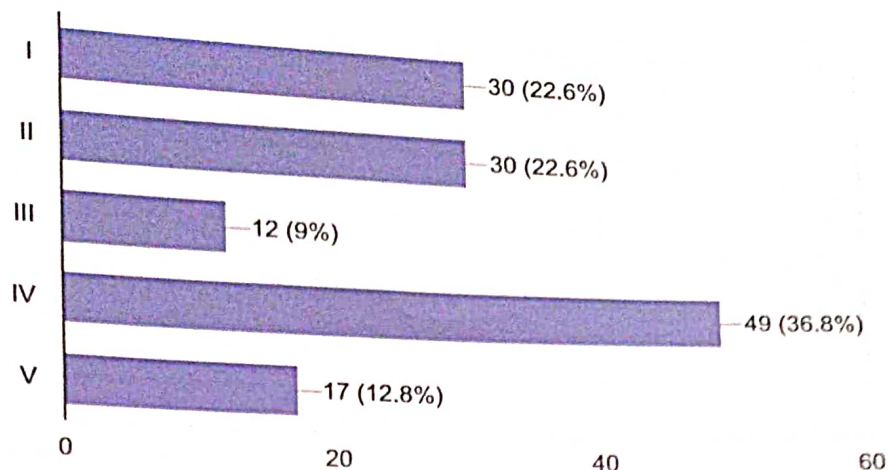

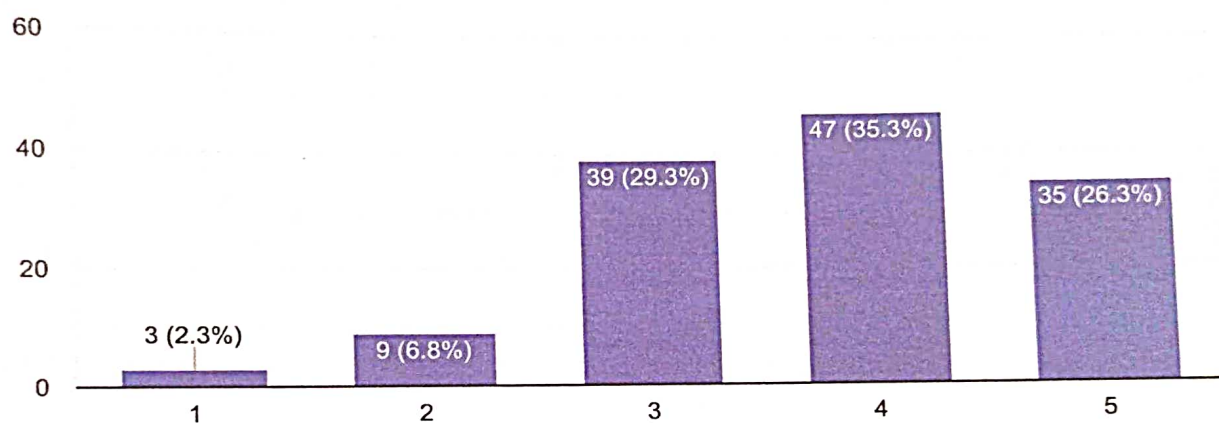

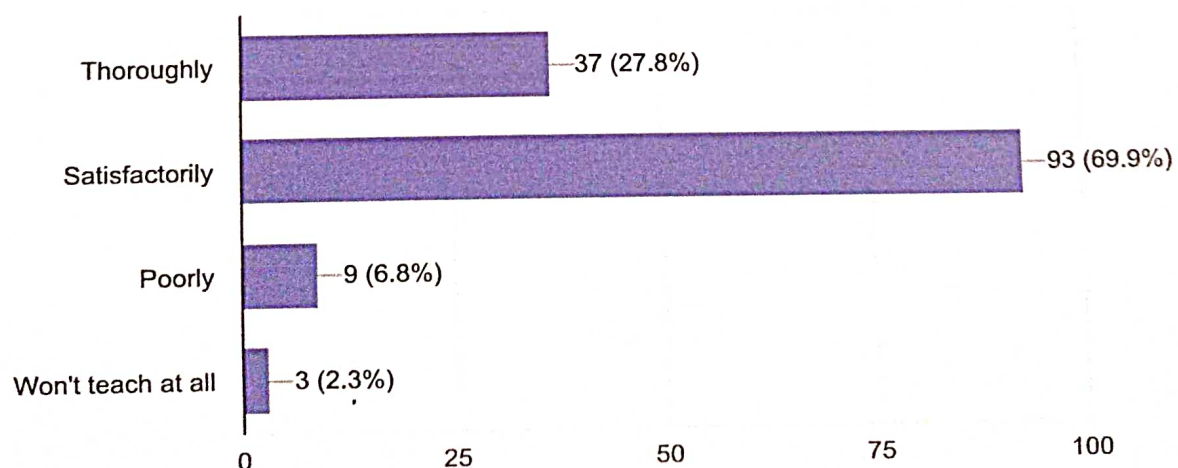

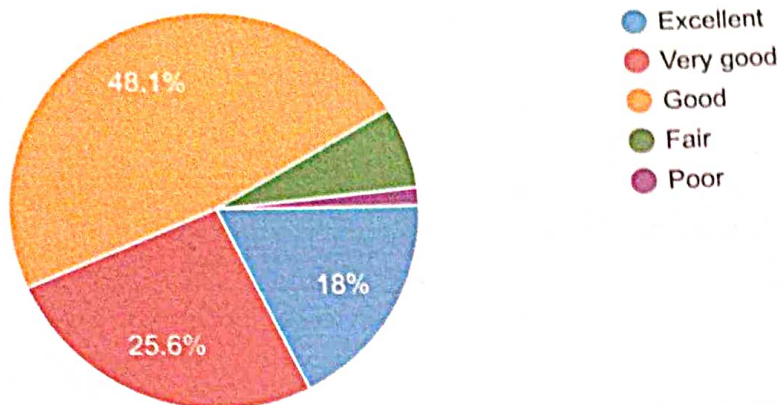

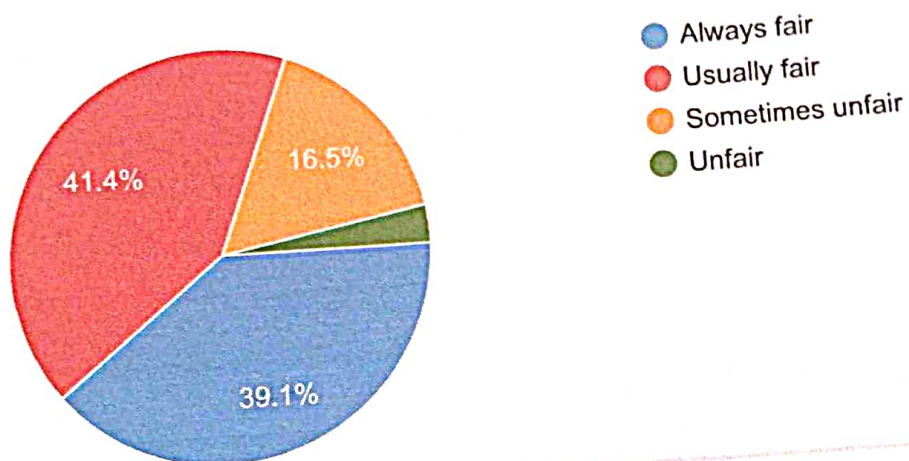

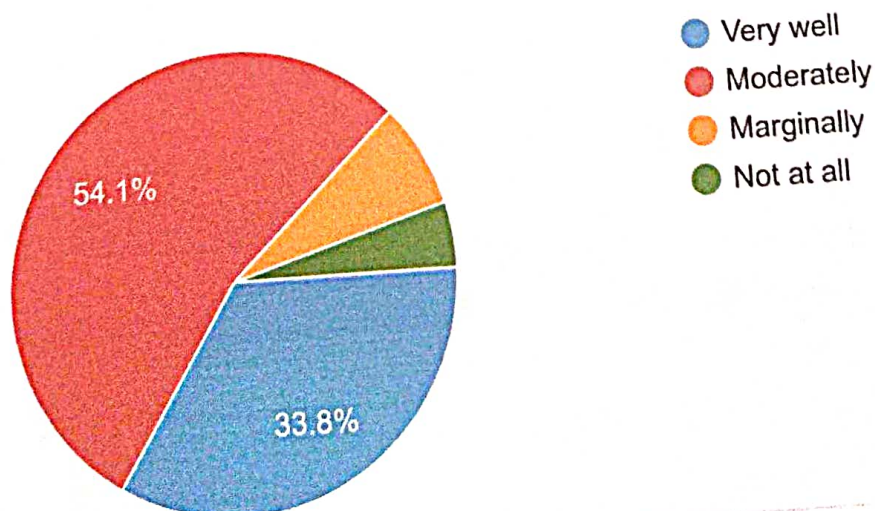

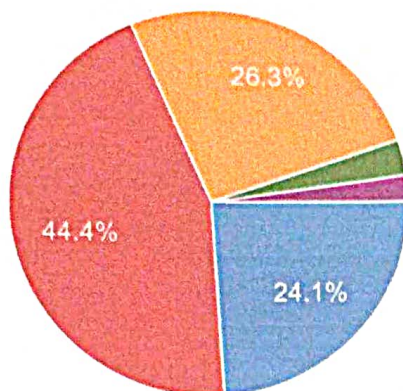

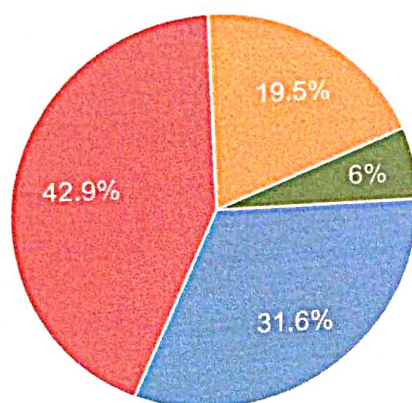

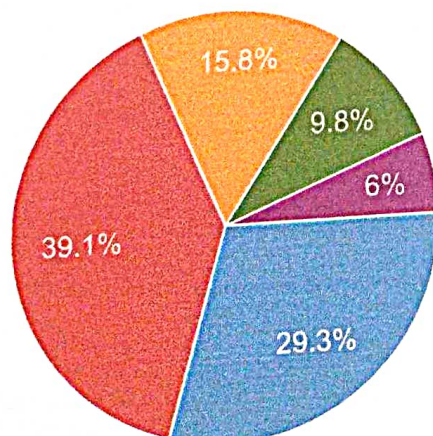

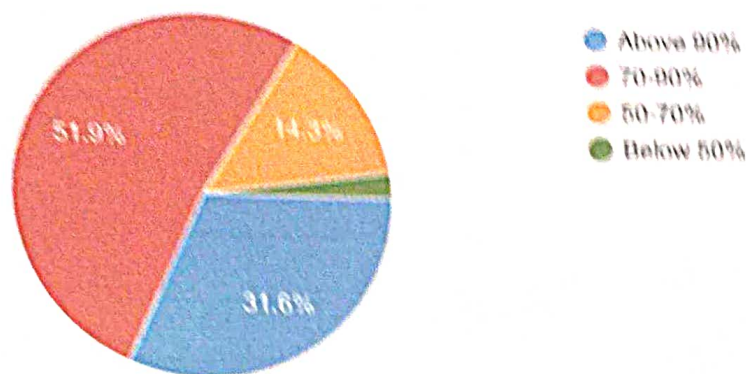

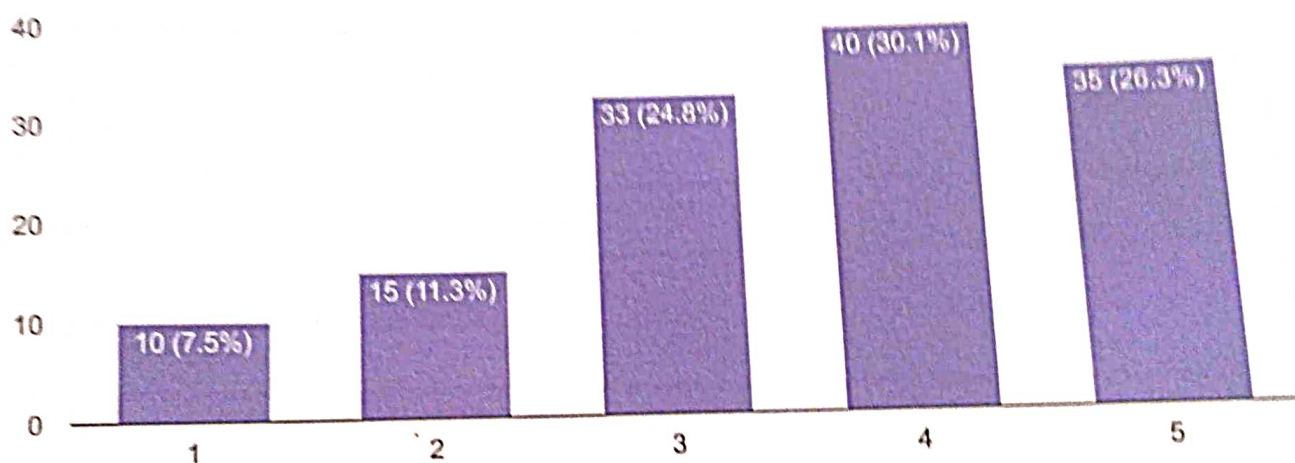

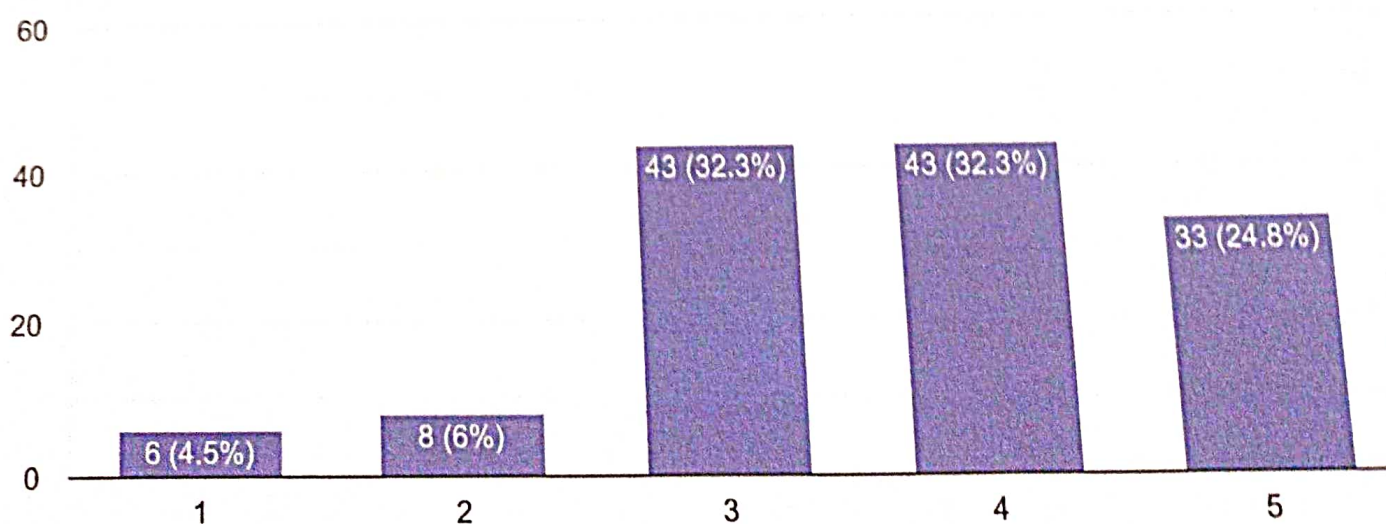
