2.6.1. Program Outcomes (POs) and Course Outcomes (COs) for all the Programs offered by the Institution are Stated and Displayed on the website and Communicated to Teachers and students.

The Program Outcomes (POs) and Course Outcomes (COs) establish the academic teaching value of each Program and Course offered by the Institute. The institution developed Program Outcomes (POs) and Course Outcomes (COs) to align with the objectives of each program, as well as the institute's Vision, Mission, and Quality Policy.

- The primary goal of program and course outcomes is to build skills that are necessary for the development of students' capacity.
- Course outcomes indicate that students will have all the core knowledge that is expected after completing the course.
- All the course outcomes are first prepared by the subject specialists, IQAC, and Academic Planning Committee members, followed by final approval from members of the Board of Studies, and then displayed on the noticeboards.
- All staff and students are notified of the Program Outcomes (POs), Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs), Program Educational Objectives (PEOs), and Course Outcomes (COs) for each program offered by the institute.
- Lesson plans are produced at the start of each academic year based on the course objectives, course outcomes, teaching resources, and total number of teaching hours.
- Newly hired employees are explained about the course and program outcomes. After the courses are assigned, they are introduced to POs, PSOs, PEOs and COs.
- At the beginning of each semester, every faculty member informs students about the course structure and associated outcomes.
- Parents and students are informed about Program Outcomes (POs) and Course Outcomes (COs) during the Orientation Program at the start of the Academic Year.
- The institute Vision, Mission, Program Outcomes (POs) and Course Outcomes (COs) are announced and posted on the College Website (www.acop.edu.in) and displayed at College Entrance, Library, Class Rooms, Laboratories, and Corridors to raise awareness among the students.
