

## OVERALL CONCLUSIONS THROUGH ANALYSIS OF STUDENTS' FEEDBACK

The feedback form for Students incorporated questions related to teaching learning process in the college. Based on responses, some conclusions were drawn.

- 1) The students seem highly satisfied with the syllabus coverage in their previous academic year/semester.
- 2) They are also satisfied with the illustration of concepts by the faculty, preparation for the classes and information given by the teacher about course and program outcomes.
- 3) They say that teachers are using ICT techniques but not in adequate manner.
- 4) Majority of students answering satisfactory for fair internal evaluation and effective study material
- 5) Majority of students opinioned that the faculty are interactive and mentored properly.
- 6) Here, from the responses of students it can be said that certain students arise a need of improvement in communication skills of their teachers such as vocabulary.
- 7) Students are **not** positive with inputs beyond curriculum.
- 8) They suggest more extra curricular activities and introduction of Pharma job related courses such as medical coding.
