6.5.1: Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has contributed significantly for institutionalizing the quality assurance strategies and processes

On July 4, 2018, Aditya College of Pharmacy launched its Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) with the goal of streamlining the institution's quality initiatives. According to the National Action Plan of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore, for performance evaluation, assessment, accreditation, and quality up gradation of higher education institutions, the institution's IQAC is active and is set up in accordance with NAAC's rules. Since then, IQAC has been a crucial component of the institution working to improve quality and advance growth in a variety of aspects. Most departments are represented, and there is a mix of senior and junior instructors.

The quality assurance techniques and procedures were established at Aditya College of Pharmacy with the aid of a very active and effective ISO 9001:2015 Quality Management System (QMS).
