POLICY DOCUMENT FOR DISABLED-FRIENDLY, BARRIER FREE **ENVIRONMENT**

A National disability policy was released by the Indian government due to the importance of making a barrier-free environment for the differently abled people and its focus the educational rehabilitation of people with impairments

Aditya college of pharmacy has implemented these policies in the teaching and learning process which acknowledges that individuals with disabilities are a crucial source of human capital for the organization and aspires to create an environment that provides them with equal opportunity, upholds their rights, and enables them to fully engage in the educational stages

The main central point of the policy is as follows:

- To assure that the architecture of the buildings, such as ramp lift, is accessible to individuals with disabilities for their convenience and provide an natural environment for them
- To graduate that disabled individuals have access to restroom facilities that are functionally safe and gender sensitive and support which is provided in washroom for their safety
- For ensuring the presence and accessibility of the necessary text and pictogram signage such as tactile walkways, lighting display boards and sign points which are also available at all the time
- Students with disabilities need enough and appropriate help both inside and outside of the classroom. This support should include the right materials, assistive technology and supportive administration, faculty and student communities
- To establish that technology and software are usable by people with disabilities
- To fortify human assistance readers, readers, scribes, and soft copies of documents which are available for research and information gathering.
