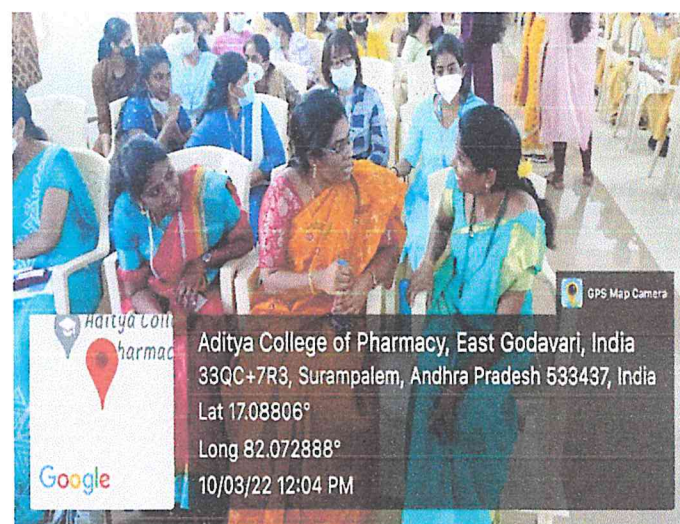
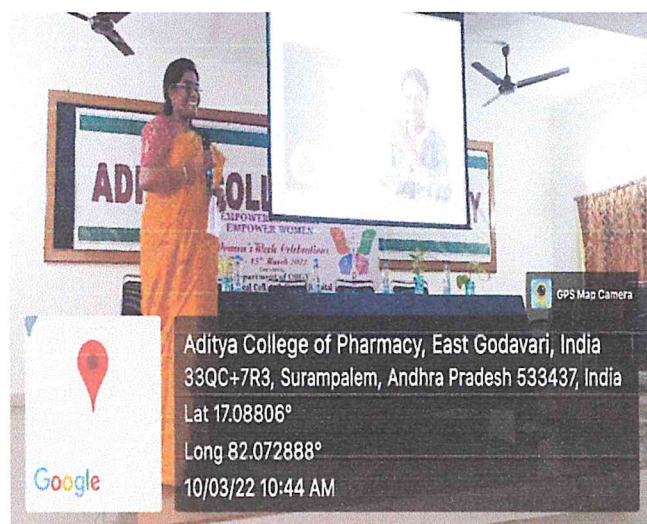
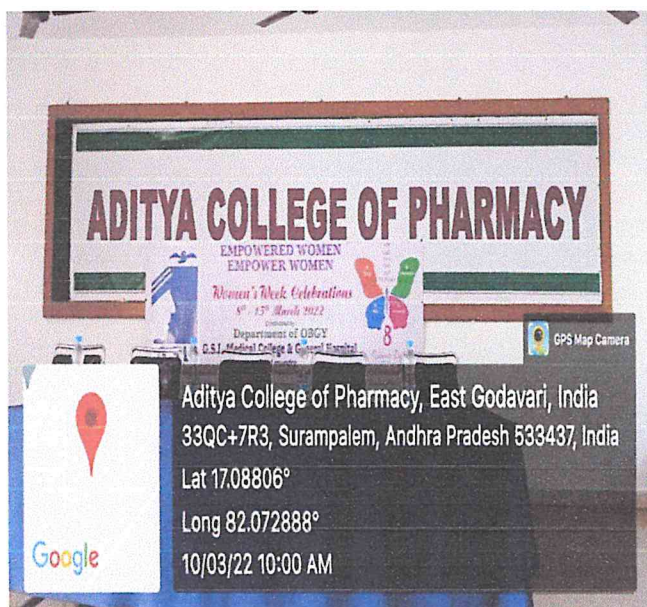

Sri Jyotsna, Obstetrics & Gynaecologist conducted a Cancer Awareness Program. As a consequence of the event, the Resource person spoke about the Human Papilloma Infection [HPV], where a large majority of cervical cancer is due to HPV. She stated that cervical cancer has no symptoms in its early stages and it can be detected early by a recommended screening test. She demonstrated the vaccination schedule of two vaccines for HPV Vaccine. The guest speaker disclosed that often the cervical cancer can be prevented by having regular screenings with Pap tests and HPV tests to find any pre-cancers and treat them. On this happening the guest focussed stating that "Cancer don't need to cure, if you can prevent it."
