Instructions for organizing the Impact Lectures (IV)

1. For conducting Impact Lecture Session in Offline Mode

- Through this impact lecture series, selected IICs will organize two lecture series in the field of innovation, startup and Intellectual Property (IP) by inviting experts to the campus.
- IIC-institutes should organize two lecture sessions with minimum 10 days' gap between two sessions
- Lectures need to be delivered by external experts only
- Minimum 200-300 numbers of students and faculties should be targeted per lecture session.
- Any extra money required to complete the program must be borne by the institute from their own resources. But the quality of the activities should not be compromised.

2. For conducting Impact Lecture Session in Online Mode

- a) E-Impact Lecture Session of minimum 1.5 hours in duration can be planned to organize by using any suitable videoconferencing platform.
- b) HEI's need to ensure minimum 200 nos, of participants, out of which 10% of participation from
- faculties and staff are expected.

 It is suggested to maintaining a minimum time gap of 7 days between two consecutive sessions.



- d) Competent and experienced experts with credibility deriving from state/national level I&E ecosystem may be invited as speaker to deliver the session. President of the IIC Institute will take the call on finalizing the experts.
- e) HC-Institute are advised to carryout e-assessment and e-feedback (either by using google form or any other suitable medium) followed by the e-impact lecture session to assess the subject level understanding of the participants.
- f) IIC Institute may issue certificates to the participants attended the e-session and submitted e-assessment successfully. For this, IIC-Institute may use the IIC Logo and MIC logo in the certificate.
- g) For the e-session, only expenditure towards honorarium to the experts will be reimbursed.
- h) Rs 3000/- towards honorarium for one expert for 1.5 Hour session and one e-impact fecture is of 3-hour duration therefore total Rs 6000/- for two experts to deliver session of 1.5 hours each will be reimbursed.
- i) Those institutes which will conduct two pending impact lectures on online mode of 3 hours' duration each with 7 days' gap between two impact lectures will be eligible for reimbursement amount of Rs 12,000/- towards honorarium to 4 experts.
- j) IIC-Institute may invite more than one experts per session to deliver. Reimbursement to experts can be made as per the reimbursement policy of the institute but should not exceed Rs.3000 to one expert per 1.5 Hour lecture. IIC-institute is free to contribute additional amount and can invite more experts if want to do so.
 - 3. Refund of grant (by way of a demand draft in favor of Member Secretary, AICTE, New Delhi)
- a. In any case, if the institute is required to refund the grant or interest accrued thereon or balance amount, the amount will be refunded to AICTE.
- b. If the college/institute does not have the Letter of Approval (LOA) or Extension of Approval issued by AICTE/Competent Authority for the academic year 2019-20, the fund released should be immediately refunded to AICTE with interest accrued thereon.
- c As AICTE needs adequate time for depositing the Demand Draft in the bank, the same he immediately dispatched to avoid any lapse of the validity period.

4. Submission of documents by college/institution after completion of Scheme

The following mandatory relevant documents are required to be submitted by the college/institution within prescribed period of the completion of the scheme: -

a. Original Statement of actual expenditure in the prescribed proforma duly signed by the Head of the institution and countersigned by Registrar/Finance Officer/Govt. Auditor

or

In case of self-financing/private institutions, Statement of actual Expenditure & Utilization Certificate are confident by a charted Accountant (with membership no., full address & stamp) Propocopies of formats are enclosed.



b. The Utilization Certificate (UC) supported by Audited Statement of Expenditure to the effect that the grant has been utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned shall be furnished to the AICTE immediately after completion of the scheme. It should contain the head-wise break up of expenditure made from the grant-in-aid provided by the Council. Audited Statement of Expenditure indicating expenditure incurred in the total duration of the scheme in the prescribed format and GFR-19 shall be submitted to the Council.

V. General instructions

- The grantee Institution shall observe all financial norms and guidelines as prescribed by the AICTE/ Government of India from time to time. GOI GFR rules (@https://doe.gov.in/ordercircular/general-financial-rules2017-0) should be followed during utilization of grant.
