Schedule of Meetings:

2. A review meet is planned at the end of every academic year to review activities facilitated and the progress of the Committee.
3. Minutes of informal meetings need to be maintained
4. The committee would meet prior to the start of an event to discuss overall planning as well as individual roles & responsibilities.

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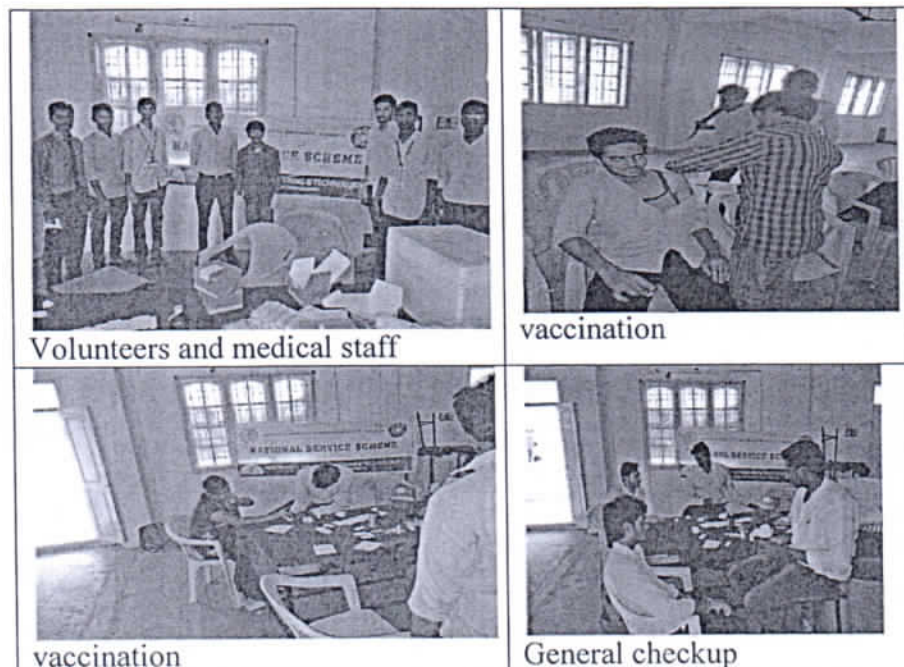
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Report on VACCINATION AND HEALTH CAMP

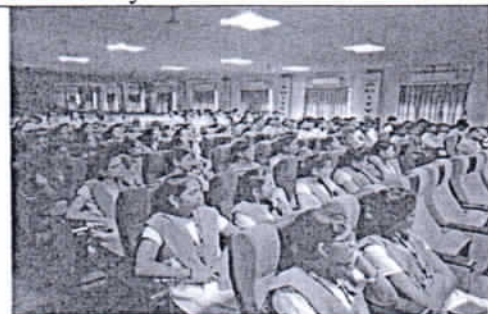

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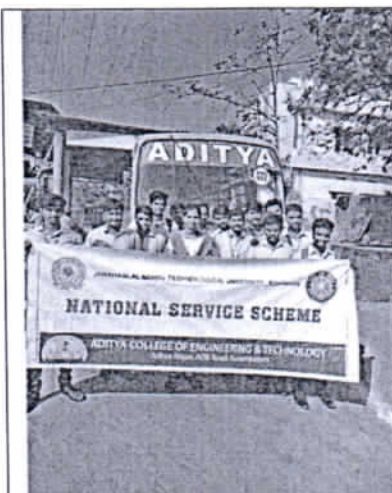
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Report on YOUTH CONVENTION PROGRAM AT VAETLAPALEM
