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
Report on QUIZ ON YOGA FOR ADITYA DEGREE COLLEGE

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
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Report on SWACHHTA PAKHWADA (15 DAYS)CAMP

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
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Report on COMMUNITY PLEDGE AT AANURU PANCHAYAT


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Report on JANMABHOOMI MAA VOORU(7DAYS) CAMP

Date: 03-01-2019to 10-01-2019 No. of Participants: 347 Venue: Aanuru and kothuru Panchayat




