

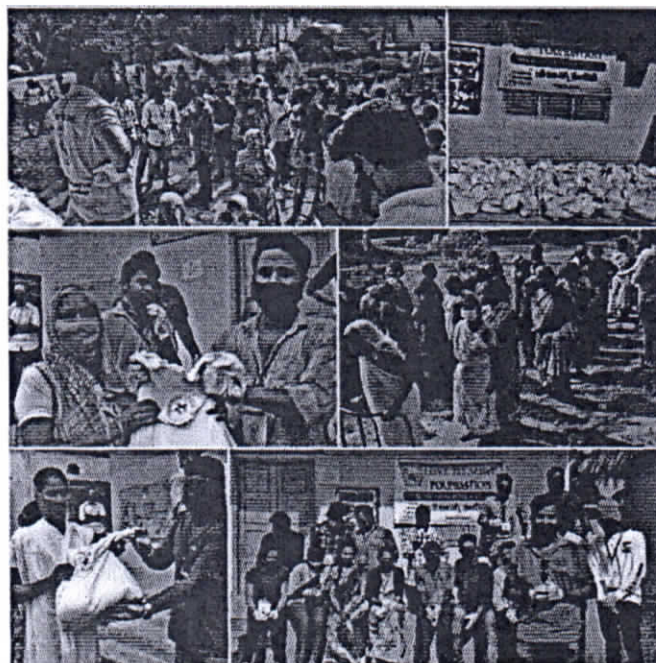

Report on 7 Day Camp at Aanuru Panchayat

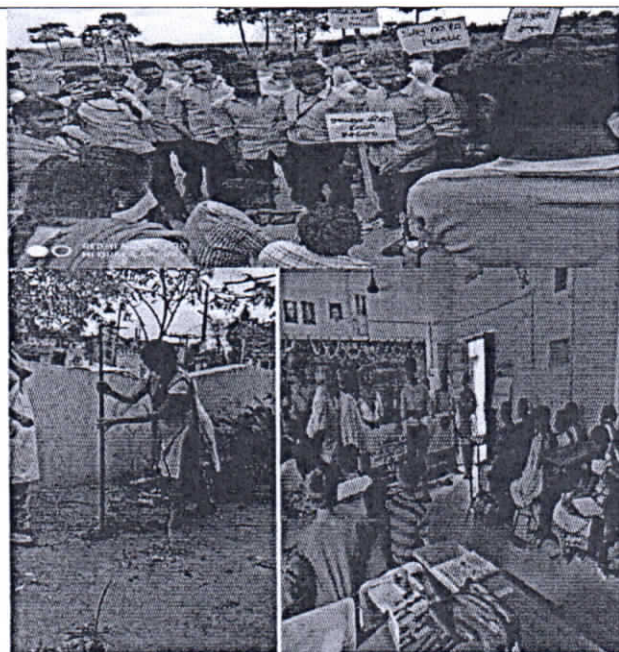
Date : 03-03-2020 to 09-03-2020

Venue : Aanuru panchayat and Primary School

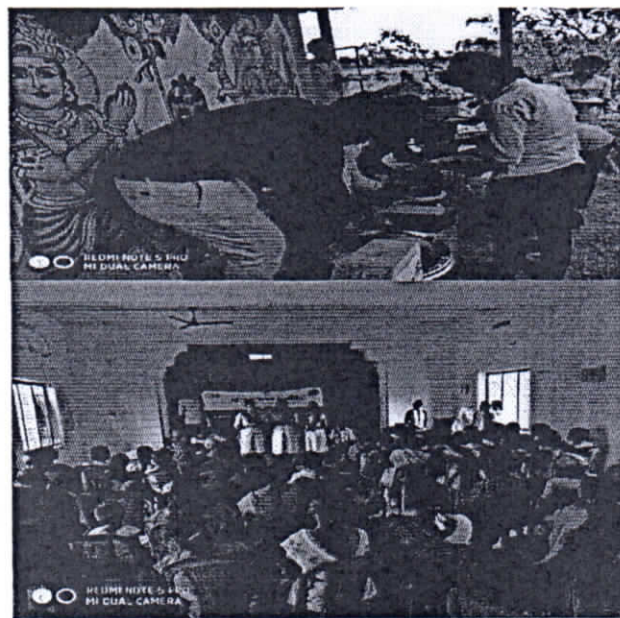
No of students Participated: 297

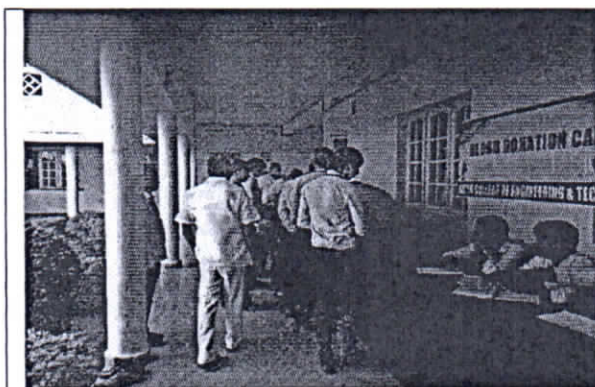
Report on Blood Donation Camp

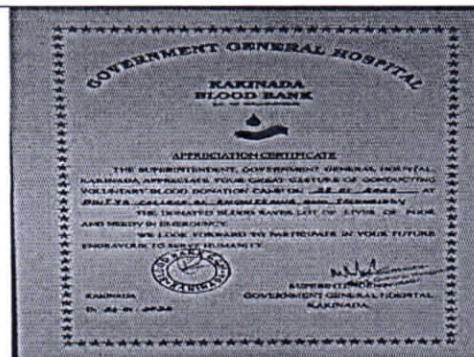

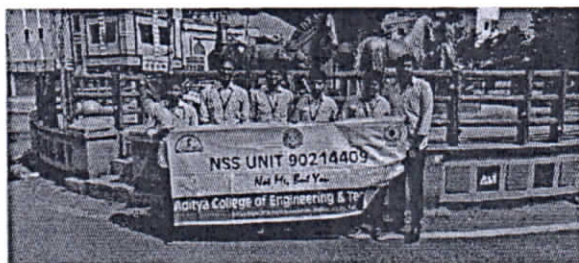

Report on Essay Writing on National Unity Day for Aditya Degree College

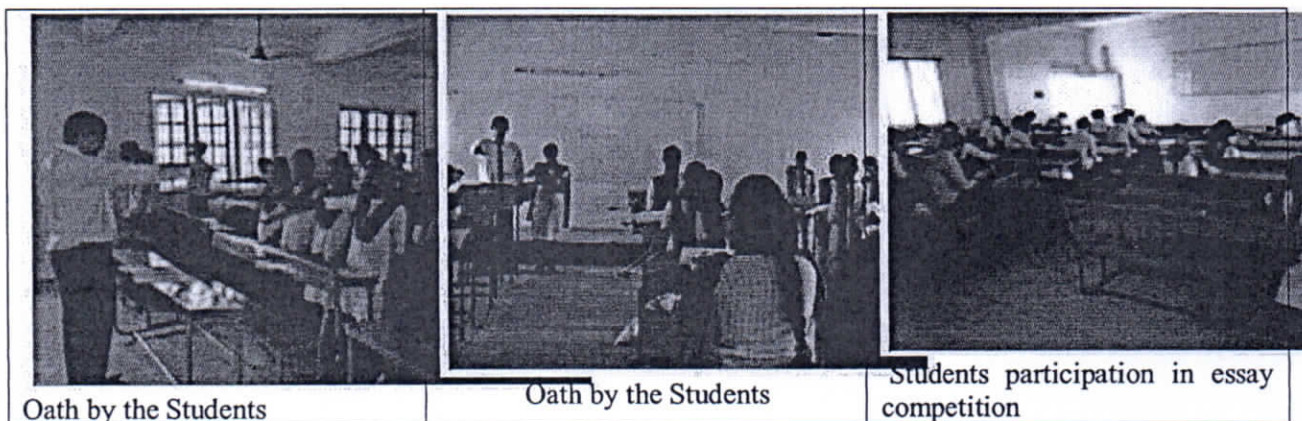

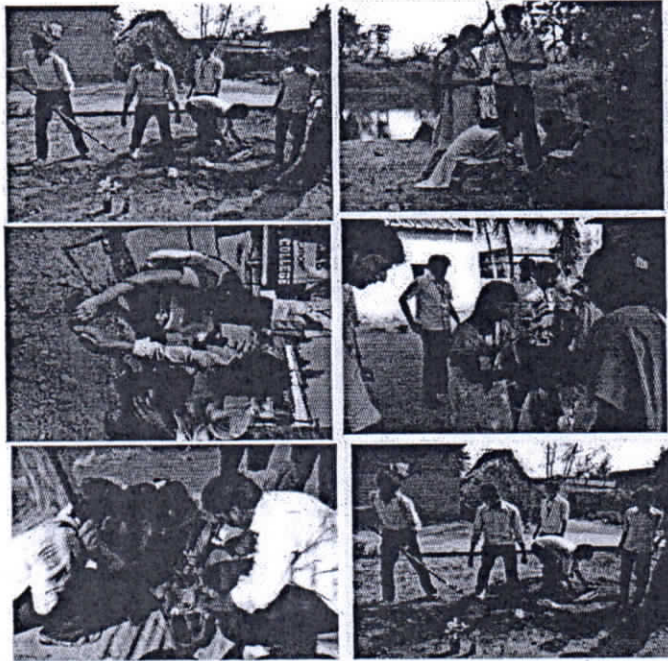
Report on Plantation of Saplings at Aanuru panchayat

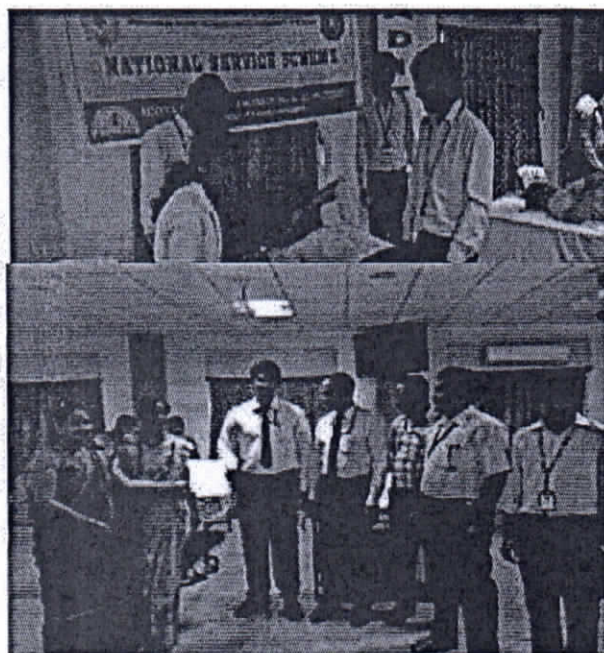
Report on Blood Donation Camp

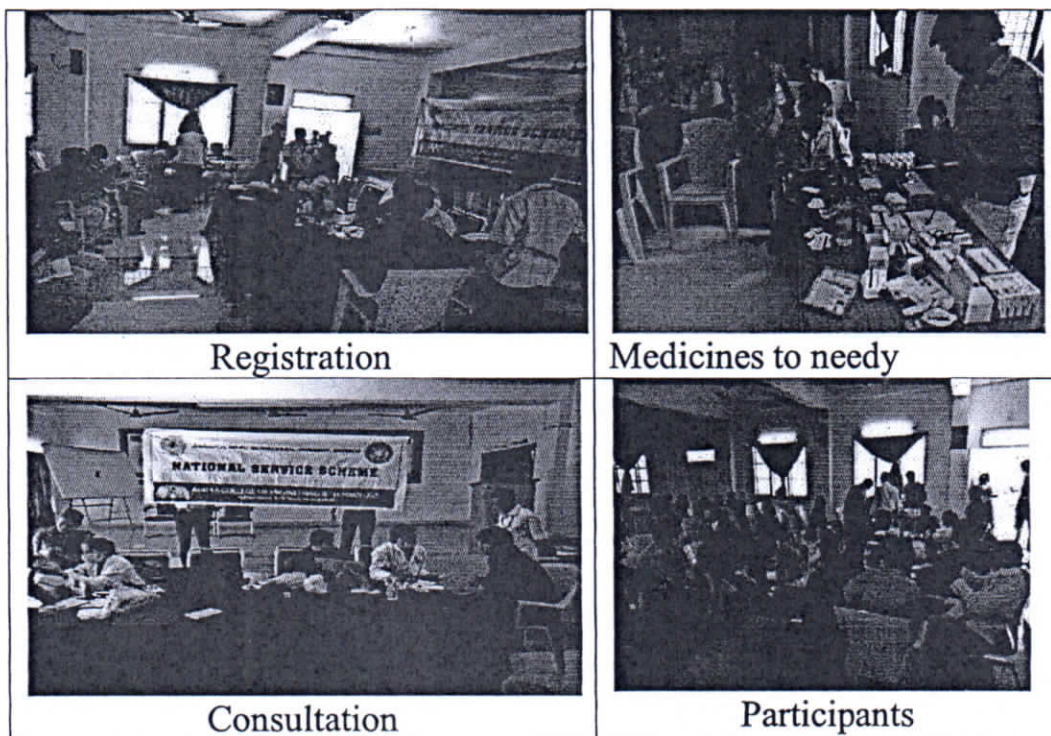
