Chief Guest: Dr. Surya Prakash, Medi cover Hospitals

Chief Guest addressed the gathering and said that Cardiac arrests and accidents are the most common type of emergencies with grave consequences, but simple maneuvers and skills can improve the outcome, and immediate CPR can double or triple the chances of survival. The majority of patients who experience an out-of-hospital cardiac arrest do not receive adequate resuscitation by health care professionals within the critical time, 3–5 min after onset, thus reducing the chance of survival.

The chance of successful resuscitation after sudden cardiac arrest decreases by 7–10% with every minute that resuscitation is delayed. Early delivery of a shock with a defibrillator (CPR, plus defibrillation) within 3–5 min of collapse can result in survival rate of 49–75%.
