NSS CAMP ACTIVITIES



On the 30th November 2019, the programme was held to raise student awareness and sensitivity about the current HIV/AIDS situation in the country, as well as to demonstrate health education to the general public about HIV/AIDS through various channels such as posters, slogans, rallies, and street-play by students. The activities for World AIDS Day 2019 were centred on the subject "Ending the HIV/AIDS Epidemic- Community by Community." A rally was held in the surrounding village of Peddapuram, as well as on campus. Around 250 second-year volunteers/students educated the community about health through encounters, slogans, banners, and other means. At the conclusion of the session, students and professors took an oath to promote a caring attitude and non-discriminatory behaviour toward those living with HIV/AIDS.

Our NSS unit, in partnership with GOVERNMENT GENERAL HOSPITAL, KAKINADA, held a blood donation camp, during which 283 units of blood were donated by students and staff members of our ADITYA COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY. It is a gesture by Aditya College of Engineering and Technology, Surampalem to bring a glimmer of hope to the urgent concerns of acute blood shortages. Every year, our college organises blood donation camps. Students and faculty members volunteer to donate blood on their own time. Medical personnel informed the pupils about the importance of blood donation and the benefits of doing so. The camp would cost Rs 1500 in total.
