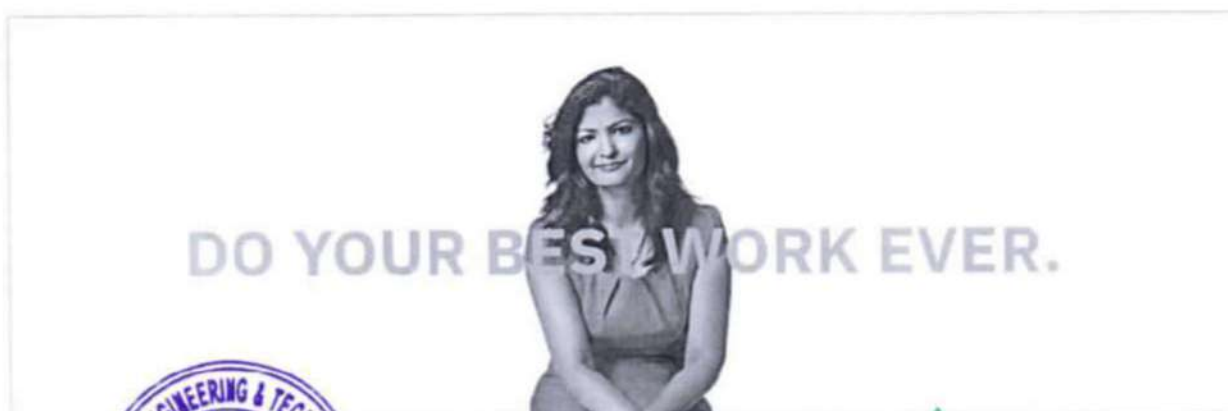

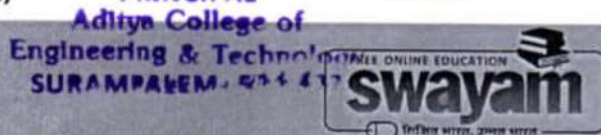

Ltd. Jayabheri Orange Towers, Sy No: 116 & 117, Road No: 02, Financial District. Nanakramguda, Hyderabad, Telangana 500032, India. 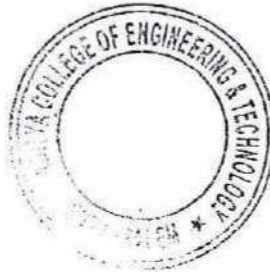


