









1. The Chairman expressed happiness on the achievements of IIPC cell and conveyed his expectation on the co-operation of the members involved in the committee.

## INDUSTRY INSTITUTE PARTNERSHIP CELL STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP) ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-2024

### 1. Creation of Cell

The Industry Institute Partnership Committee is established at ACOE under the Industry Institute Partnership (IIP) scheme of the college with an anticipation of considerable progress year –by- year and the academic departments are decided to carry out various activities under the IIP independently and with support from the training and placement cell as deemed necessary.

### 2. The objectives of Industry – Institute Partnership

The IIP cell is established with the following major objectives:

- To evolve educational programs that are consistent with the broad requirements of the industry and also that can give rise to engineering personnel capable of coping-up with the accelerating pace of the technological development.
- To create adequate facilities for updating knowledge of professional engineers and technologists to meet growth and development needs of the industry.
- To coordinate the research and development activities between Industry and Institute.

### 3. Strategy Adopted for Industry – Institute Partnership

#### 3.1 The concept

The Industry Institute Partnership would accrue mutual benefits when a symbiotic relationship is developed between the two systems. The ultimate aim of this relationship will be the creation of confidence in industry by the institute which would result

industries involving voluntarily the Institute at various stages of its development. The development of such symbiotic relationship requires firstly careful understanding of the industry needs such as relevant R&D, cost effectiveness, time bound programmes, technology upgradation etc by the Institute and in turn understanding the capabilities and limitations of the institute to meet industry needs.

Recognizing the above, the following thrust areas have been identified which require immediate action:

- Reorientation of Curriculum based on industry requirement
- Inviting experts from Industry and exposing our faculty to Industry need
- Institute to gain Confidence of to meet Industry needs
- Industry acting as a consultant in R&D

### 3.2 Roadmap

In keeping with the above thrust areas, following action plan has been prepared by the Institute to fulfill the aims of Industry Institute Partnership into achievements:

- Preparing/ updating of an information brochure giving salient features of the Institute including various programmes, R&D activities (completed/ ongoing) and expertise available.
- Identifying and preparing/ updating a list of executives and technologists from various industries/ establishments in the region and working out a system of inviting them to address the faculty and students.
- Preparing/ updating a comprehensive directory of technology experts in different fields of expertise and knowhow continuing links with them through various means of involvement like talks, guest lectures, research collaborations, and students project guidance, training seminars etc.
- Reviewing graduate and post graduate curricula and reorient these to meet the needs of the industry by involving experts from industry in framing certificate courses.
- Organizing refresher courses/ training programmes for students.

- Making MOUs and Agreements with various industrial and research organizations in different fields and sectors to promote various forms of interactions.
- Arranging Industry related training activities in college premises.
- Imparting in-plant training to students and faculty members at industries.
- Organizing Entrepreneurship Awareness Camp for senior students.
