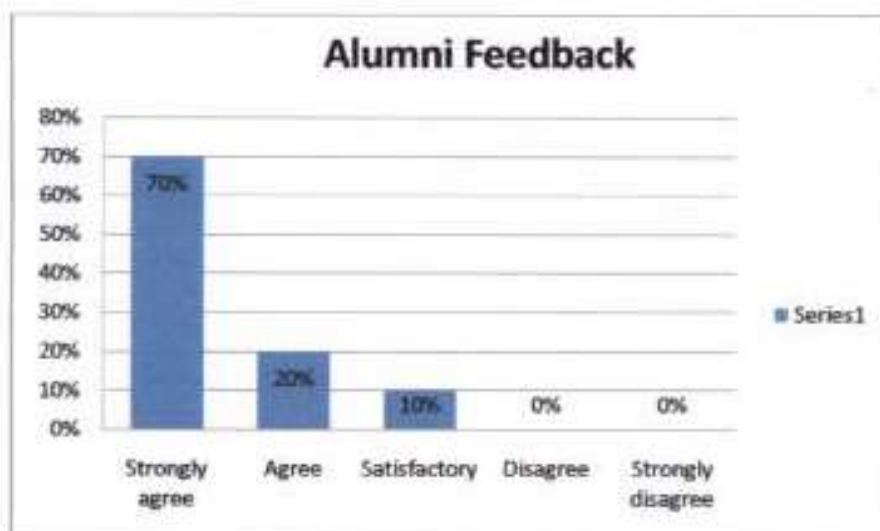

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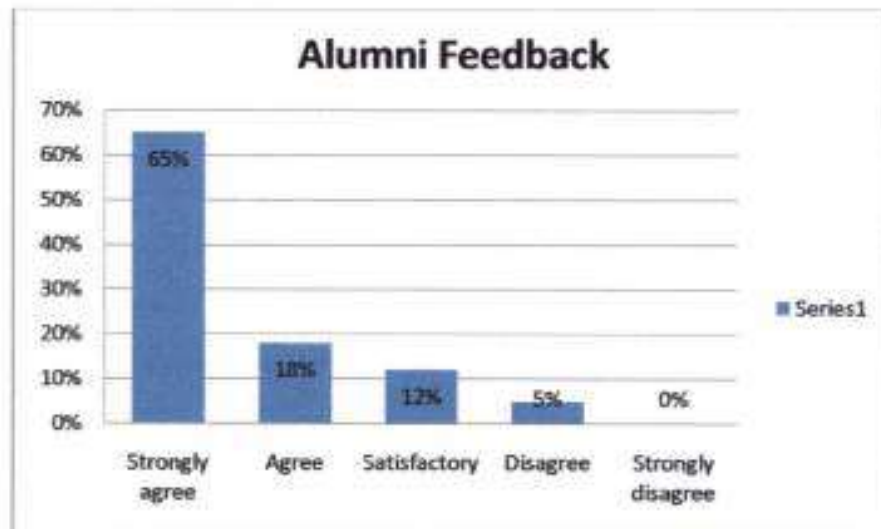
1. is the course curriculum well designed and covers from fundamentals to advanced topics?

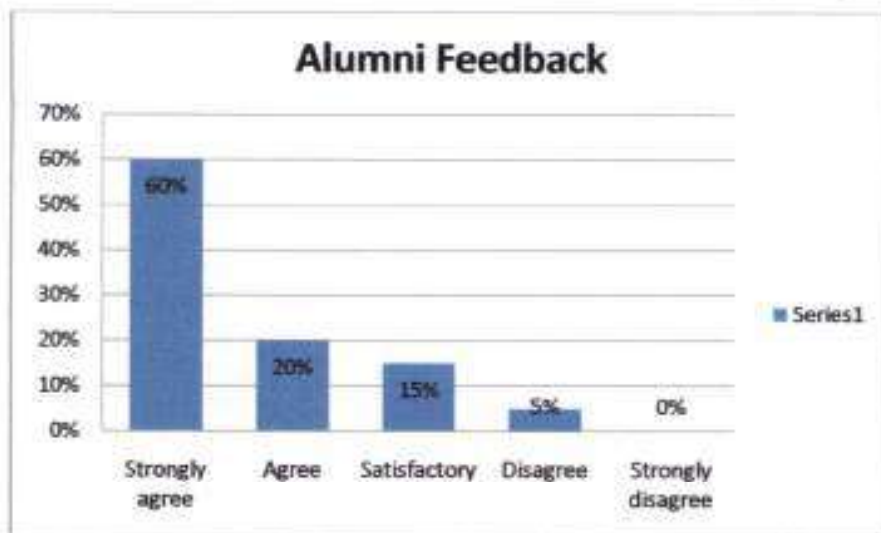
2. Does the curriculum have enough emphasis in the practical courses?

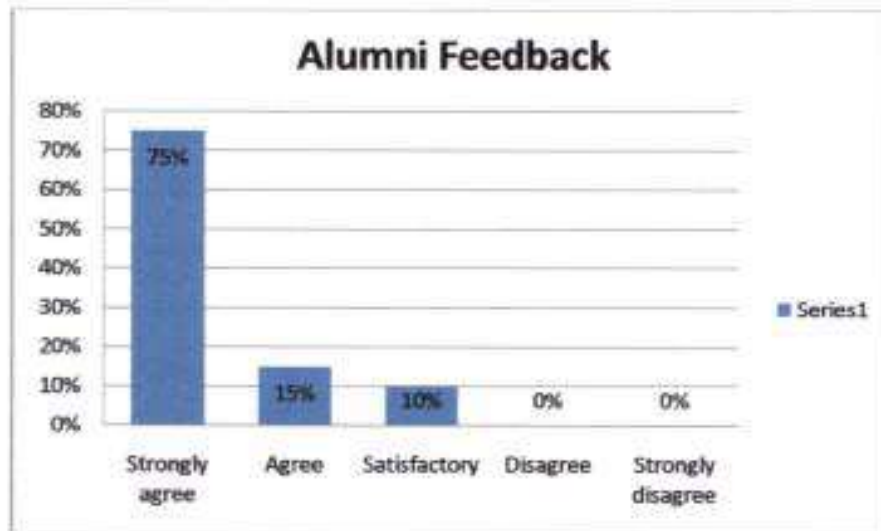
3. Do the courses of curriculum have relevance to the present scenario?

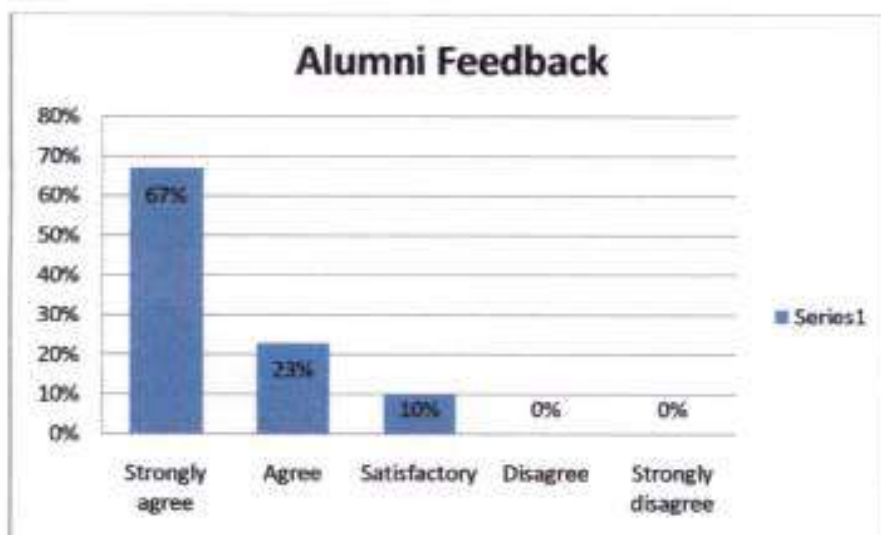
4. Does the curriculum sensitize the students for the issues related to gender equality, effective communication, professional ethics and social responsibilities?

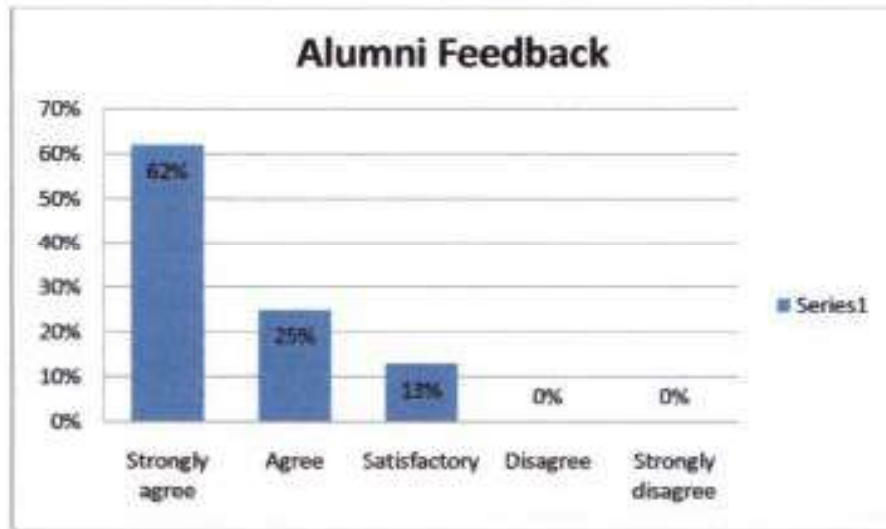
5. Does the curriculum give enough scope to opt elective courses /open elective courses?

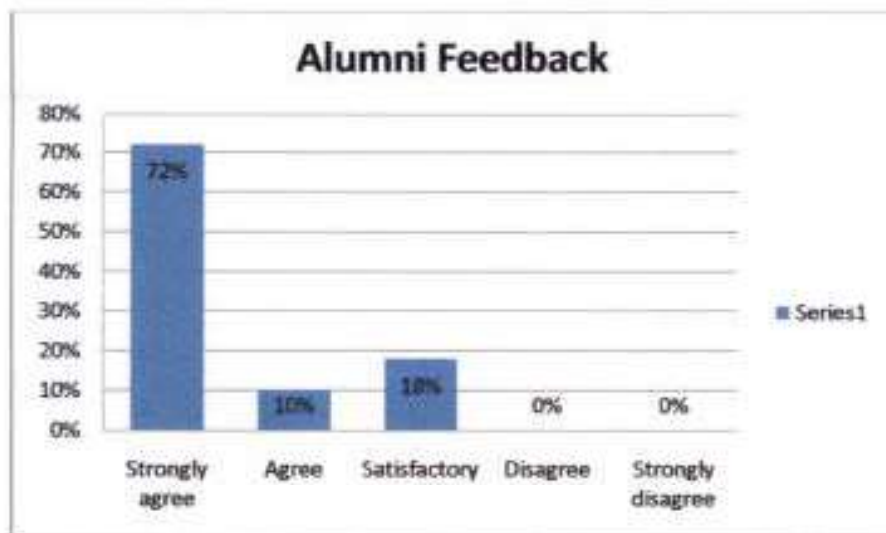
6. Do the Courses studied applicable in practical way?

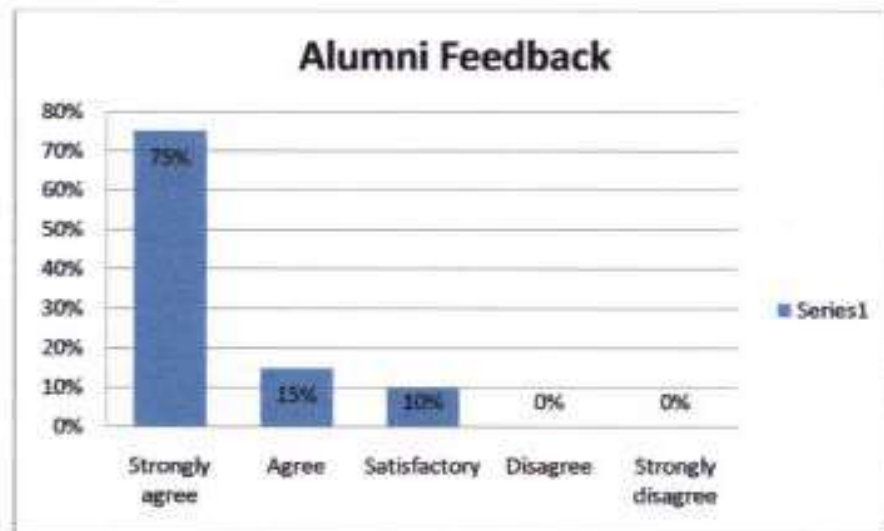
7. Is the curriculum appropriate to achieve the industry – academic connects?

2. Sufficient teaching hours are allotted per week to discuss the curriculum in detail.

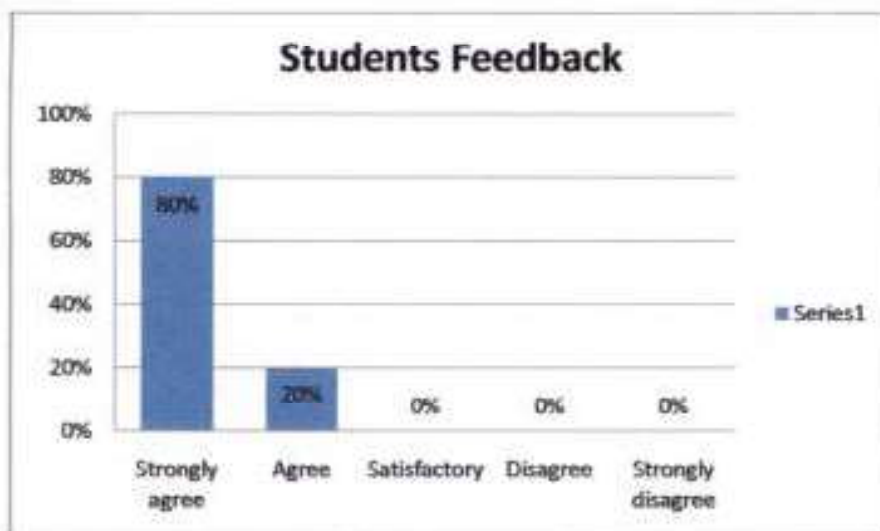

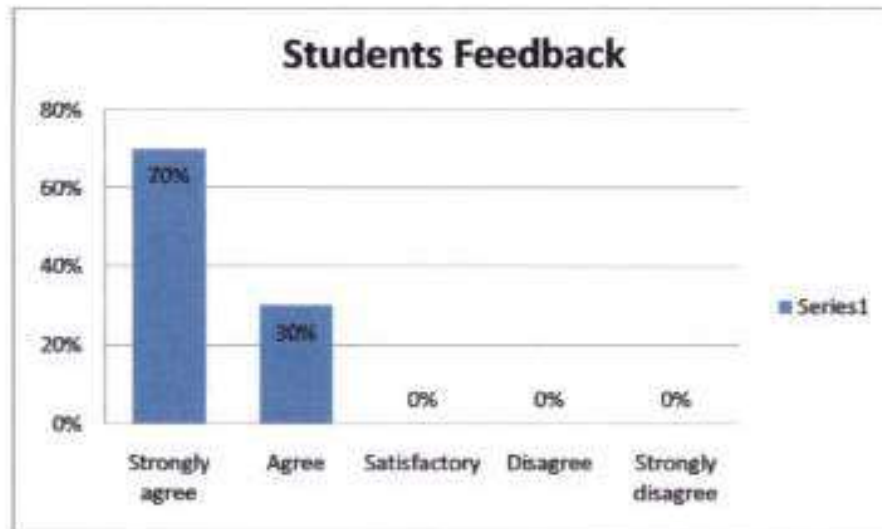
3. By studying this curriculum, leaning value (skill, concept, knowledge, analytical ability) of the alumni' will enhance?

It is observed that 80%of the stakeholders are strongly agreed, 20% of the stakeholders are agreed, with the statement.



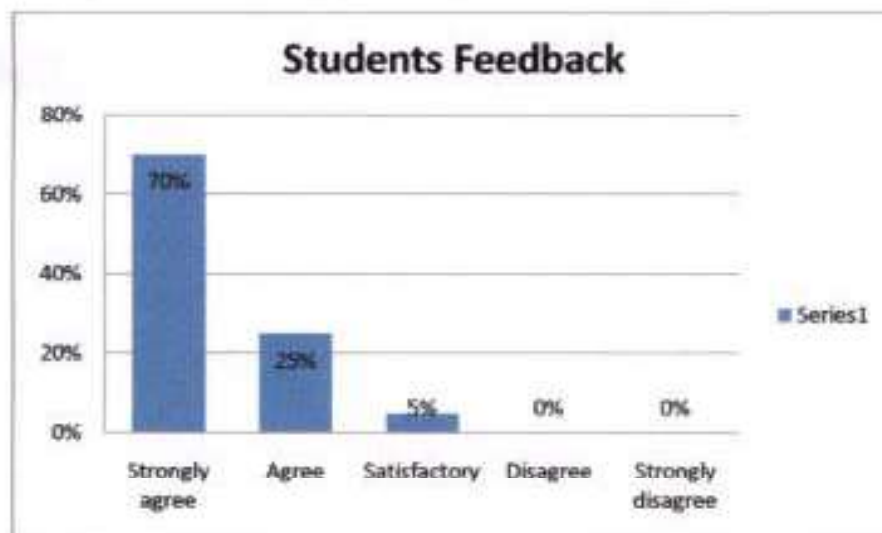
